

Board Minutes Excerpt - Summer Work Schedule, Yosemite Community College District, 2/2/93 Board Meeting

Board Item - Summer Work Schedule

In an effort to both conserve energy and reduce costs, a proposal to modify our summer work schedule has emerged.

By moving to a 4-day work week (four ten-hour days), our energy savings would be at least \$30,000. By consolidating programs and services to fewer buildings, and avoiding evening use of facilities, the savings could grow to as much as \$80,000 to \$100,000. It was suggested that a decision be made early in order to allow for discussions as to exactly what programs we can afford to offer in the summer.

It was moved by Dr. Bare, seconded by Mr. Allen, that the Board of Trustees approve the concept of a 4-day work week for the summer of 1993, with details of the proposed schedule to be brought back to the Board at a later date.

The motion carried unanimously.
