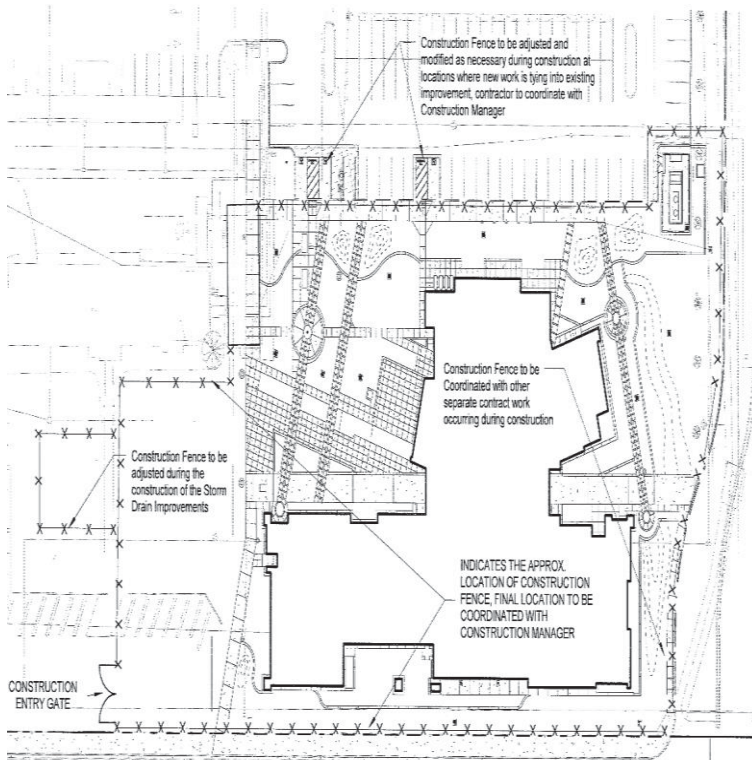
DISTRICT OFFICE BUILDING

Access: Traffic will be redirected to G-Street North of Lot 207.

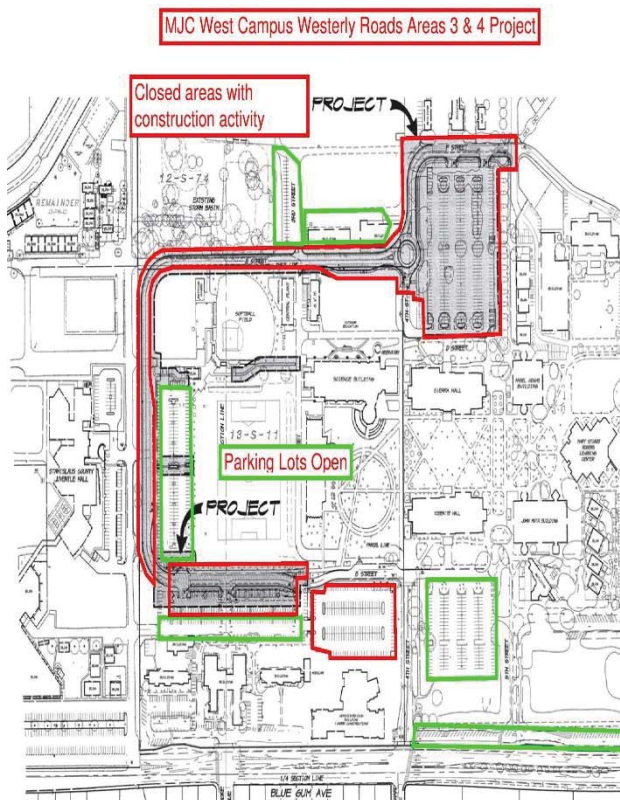
Noise: Extreme noise due to heavy construction equipment.

SOLAR ARRAY PROJECT

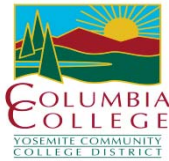
Work this week: Electrical work and installation of modules to begin this week. Continue painting of steel.

Lower Manzanita Asbestos Abatement

Work this week: Interior remediation of hazardous and non-hazardous materials continues in the lower Manzanita Building. Work hours are from 4:00 PM to 1:00 AM Monday through Friday. During that time, the only work outside of the contained area will be to move secured bags of material to the utility bins located in the Bus Turnaround area. The bins may be removed and replaced on a daily basis during regular business hours.

Access: Caution should be taken when using the Bus Turnaround where the trash bins are stored.
Noise: Moderate to extreme noise could occur occasionally during working hours.
