Work this week: Mechanical, electrical and plumbing subcontractors are scheduled to finish MEP systems. Also, epoxy landings at exterior doors will be installed along with door trim and door closers.

Access: limited access to Oak Pavilion parking lot and no access to Symons Field Rd.


Noise: Moderate noise will occur due to demolition activities.
