Work this week: Mechanical, electrical and plumbing subcontractors are scheduled to finish MEP systems. Also, the Fire Alarm System will be tested on Tuesday the 17th.

Odors: Low Impact

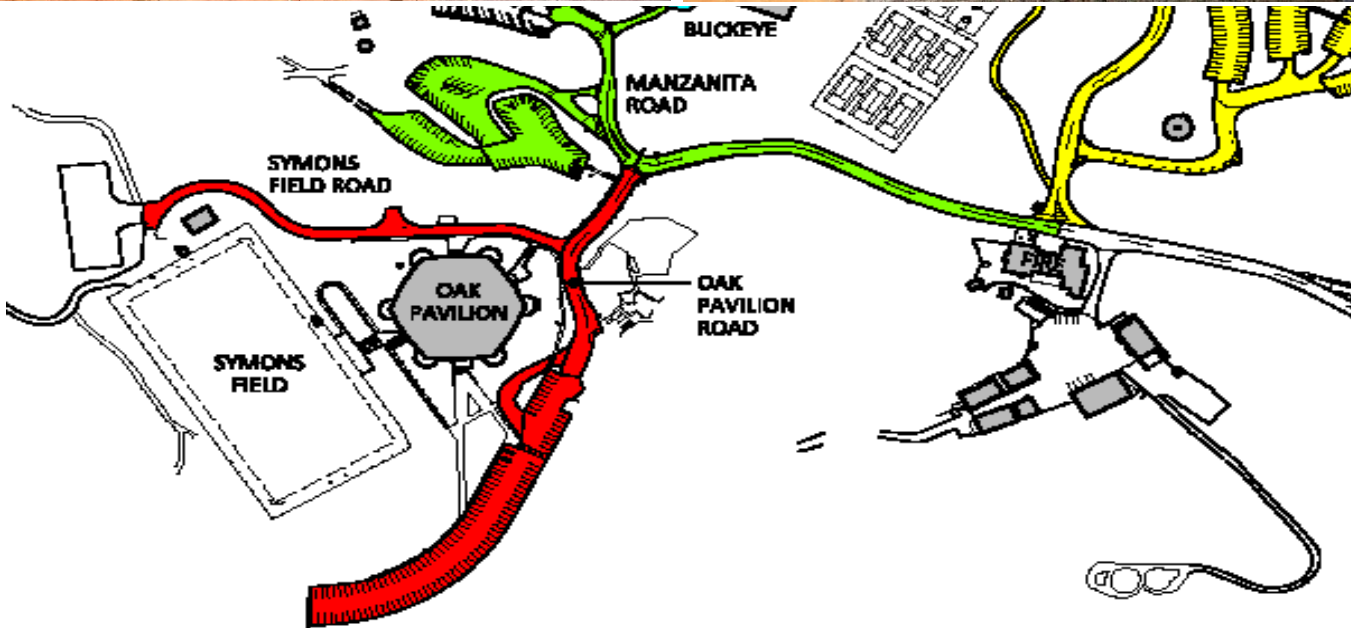
Utilities: No impact to utilities is anticipated.
