Manzanita Building Modernization

Work this week: Ceiling panel installation continues this week. Fire alarm finish will come to a close in the middle of the week to make way for testing and inspection the final two days. Installation for casework & PLM tops will come to a close towards the beginning of the week. The first couple of days we will also be installing miscellaneous wiring & ending the week with cap installation for the entry archway & downspout columns.
