Manzanita Building Modernization

Work this week: Starting the month of May we will be wrapping up construction activity. For this week exterior paint application will continue. Glass marker boards are now up & we are going to continue installing redwood trim around them. Tack board is due to be installed this week. Flooring is complete & we are now installing vinyl baseboard throughout the building which will be complete at the end of the week. Minor electrical work continues with the calibration of lighting to take place. Miscellaneous work will occur throughout the coming days along with extensive cleaning.
