Work this week: Mechanical, Plumbing, and Electrical (MEP) work in the ceilings and attics continues. Installation of the T-Bar dropped ceilings is complete on the first floor. Casework deliveries and installations will continue on the first floor. Spray applied texturing is complete on the second floor with final coats of interior painting due this week. Stucco finishes on the second floor are complete. The Applications of the exterior stucco finishes continue on the first floor.

Site work: Roadwork on the site is still on hold as the priorities stay with the interior finishes. Boom lifts are still being utilized for exterior areas for second floor access to exterior finishes. The weather continues to interfere with the site work but this will will hopefully allow it to dry out to start regrading the roads in April.
