SCIENCE AND NATURAL RESOURCES BUILDING

Work this week: Mechanical, Plumbing, and Electrical (MEP) controls, sequencing and balancing is in progress. Interior low voltage cabling and terminations will continue this week. The flooring is complete in all areas; the ceilings are complete, the case work is complete. Exterior painting will be completed this week at the exterior. The concrete topping slab on the second floor deck is complete. All deck railing is complete and the stair railing will be complete this week.

Site work: All major road work and walkways have been completed. The landscape wall will be complete by the end of the week. Boom lifts are still being utilized for exterior areas for second floor access to exterior finishes. Landscape grading, irrigation, planting and mulch will continue this week with minimal dust.
