PROGRAM PROGRESS

Campus Way Parking Lot: The contract is in the process of being approved.

High Availability Data Center: The concept design continues. The site survey is complete and environmental testing is in the process of being scheduled.

YCCD Shipping and Receiving Project: The programming and the design process are under way.

DESIGN PROGRESS

Art Building: The construction documents have been approved by the Division of State Architects (DSA).

High Tech Center: The project is in the design phase.

Library Learning Resource: This project is being reprogrammed to incorporate an integrated learning center.

Softball Restroom/Concession Stand Project: Construction drawings have been approved by DSA. The project will go out to bid in December of 2010.

Utility Infrastructure Increment Two: Construction documents have been approved by DSA. This project is anticipated to bid late fall of 2010.

CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS

Agriculture Animal Facility (Beef and Sheep Units): The Beef and Sheep Units are complete and occupied.

Agriculture Multipurpose Pavilion: The project is currently under construction. The user group continues to meet to discuss equipment selection for this building.

Allied Health: The project is under construction. The substantial completion date is May of 2011.

Central Plant Building: The project is currently under construction and its anticipated completion date is December of 2010.

Founders Hall: Construction has begun with abatement and demolition. Demolition should be complete by end of October of 2010.

Founders Hall Interim Housing (Swing Space): The project is complete and in the closeout phase.


Founders Hall Secondary Effects: The project is complete and in the closeout phase.

Science Community Center and Great Valley Museum: Construction has begun. The Great Valley Museum design has been finalized.

Softball Complex: Construction is complete. A ribbon cutting ceremony took place on September 25 of 2010.

Student Services: Construction is in progress with steel erection and concrete reinforcements installation underway.

Utility Infrastructure Increment One: The project is under construction. Substantial completion is December of 2010.
