YCCD Primary Data Center: The construction documents have been reviewed and approved by the Department of State Architect.

West Campus Parking Lot: Project has been approved and is now in the Design phase.

## CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS

Ag Pavilion Bleachers: The bleachers are being fabricated.

Ag Pavilion Parking Lot Extension: Project is in the bid phase.

**Allied Health:** Construction is complete. Project is in the closeout phase.

**Art Building:** The project is complete and it is owner occupied. The project is in the closeout phase.

**Central Plant Building**: The construction is complete. Project is currently under the closeout phase.

Central Plant Fencing: Project is under way.

**Founders Hall Interim Housing:** Removal of the modular units is complete the parking lot has been restored.
