Art Building: The project is complete and it is owner occupied. The project is in the closeout phase.

Campus Way Parking Lot: Construction is complete and the lot is being used by the East Campus students.

Central Plant Building: The construction is complete. Project is currently under the closeout phase.

Central Plant Fencing: Project is under way.

Founders Hall Interim Housing: Removal of the modular units is complete the parking lot has been restored.

Science Community Center and Great Valley Museum: Project is under construction. The Great Valley Museum design has been finalized and exhibits are under construction.

Softball Restroom/Concession Stand: This project has been closed out.
