



# Measure E Bond Program Phase I Projects

#### PROGRAM PROGRESS

**Central Services Projects**: Committee meetings have been scheduled.

**High Availability Data Center:** District is negotiating a contract and scope of services with a data center consultant.

**Turlock Educational Site:** Various properties are being considered for site acquisition.

**West Side (Patterson) Site:** Anticipated completion date is January 2011.

**YCCD Solar & Lighting Project:** A committee is being formed by the Chancellor.

### DESIGN PROGRESS

**Art Building:** The construction documents have been submitted to the Division of State Architects (DSA) for review and approval.

**Founders Hall:** The construction documents are currently being reviewed by the DSA for approval. Construction is anticipated to begin in the fall of 2010.

**High Tech Center:** The project is currently in the design development phase.

**Interim Housing (Swing Space):** Increment one site work construction documents have been approved by DSA with construction starting this month. Completion anticipated for August 2010.

**Library Learning Resource:** The Library program has been finalized and meetings with the Architect are in progress for schematic design.

Science Community Center and Great Valley Museum: The project will bid on April 15, 2010. Construction is anticipated to start in May. **Student Services:** Construction bids were submitted on March 17, 2010. Construction is anticipated to start the end of April or early May of this year. Notice of award is in progress.

## **Secondary Effect Swing Space Project:**

The drawings have been finalized and the construction work is scheduled to be completed by August of 2010. Bid is scheduled for April.

**Softball Restroom/Concession Stand Project:** Contract has been signed with the Lionakis Architect firm. Design is under way.

**Utility Infrastructure Increment Two:** Construction documents are being reviewed by DSA for approval.

## **CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS**

Agriculture Animal Facility (Beef and Sheep Units): Projects are currently under construction. The anticipated completion date for the Beef and Sheep Unit is July 19, 2010. The user group continues to coordinate equipment needs for the facilities.

**Agriculture Multipurpose Pavilion:** Project is currently under construction. Contract completion date is December 26, 2010. User group continues to meet to discuss furniture, fixtures, and equipment selection for this building.

Allied Health: Project is currently under construction.

**Central Plant Building**: Construction is anticipated to start April 5, 2010.

**Softball Complex:** Construction is scheduled to be completed this month.

**Utility Infrastructure Increment One:** Project is under construction. Duration of project is anticipated for 9 months. Substantial completion is October of 2010.
