Measure E Coordinating Committee Update

Measure E meetings resumed on January 31 as the Educational Master Plan nears completion. Campus Master Planning will begin soon and will determine the future growth at both MJC's East and West campuses.

The project planning process continues for the MJC East and West Campuses.

Allied Health: Design process continues with the project committee. Detailed floor plans with exterior elevations were provided. Budget analysis will be finalized in order to align the project's budget.

Agricultural Complex (including the Living Units, Pavilion and Animal Units): Agriculture Project Committee continues to meet with the design team.

Parking Structure: Conceptual design is in process. Traffic studies continue. Site surveying for the two proposed sites are complete. Geotechnical surveying continues.

The **Student Services** and the **Softball Field** projects continue to be on hold pending the outcome of the Educational Master Plan and Campus Master Plan.

West Side Center: The project's committee is in the process of preparing the Business Plan. The preparation of the state application continues for the aeronautical study of land donation.

CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS

Auditorium Project: Construction continues throughout the building exterior and interior. Demolition is complete.



Foundation work continues.



Utility lines (plumbing and electrical) located below the floor slab will continue on the interior building.
