**Secondary Access (Emergency) Road:** Work has been completed.



As part of the project, a gravel lot for overflow parking is being constructed adjacent to Symons Field. This was completed concurrent with the access road work.

### Disabled Lot/Bus Service Loop Area:

Lot.

Odors: No unusual odors are expected in the

coming month.
