Measure E Bond Program Phase I Projects

Program Progress

Phase I of the Measure E Bond Program for Modesto Jr. College includes a major capital improvement projects on both east and west campus.

The planning firm of BFGC is in the process of locating sites for the new projects and future building sites, and reviewing the existing infrastructure systems on both East and West campuses.

Aerial Topography flights have been performed for both East and West Campuses. The aerial topography maps will be essential tools for the planning process.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Proposal reviews for East and West campuses are under review.

Selected architectural firms for Student Services Building and the Softball Complex are both in contract negotiation.

Room programming and cost modeling for Allied Health and the Agricultural Complex (including the Greenhouse, Living Units, Pavilion and Animal Units) are currently being developed and nearing completion.
