Call For YCCD Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee Members

MODESTO, CA – The Yosemite Community College District (YCCD) Board of Trustees, is currently seeking applications from qualified individuals interested in serving on the YCCD Measure E Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee. Although no current vacancies exist on the committee, the applications will serve to replenish the pool of qualified applicants.

Eligible applicants include YCCD residents who represent the following categories: business representatives, senior citizen group representatives, tax payer organization members, current Modesto Junior College or Columbia College students, members of college support organizations or community members at large. Employees or officials of the District, vendors, contractors or consultants of the District are not eligible to serve on the committee. The Chancellor and members of the Board of Trustees will screen applications.

YCCD's Bond Measure E is a \$326.1 million bond measure passed in November 2004 for improvements at Columbia College, Modesto Junior College, and the expansion of college outreach sites. The committee's primary functions are to inform the public regarding the use of the bond funds, to review expenditures and to prepare an Annual Report.
