Columbia College Vice President Appointed

COLUMBIA, CA — The California Community Colleges State Board of Governors has appointed Dr. Dennis Gervin, Vice President of Student Learning at Columbia College as one of 21 individuals state-wide to a Task Force on Student Success examining best practices for promoting student success and adopting a plan for improving student success within the California Community Colleges — as a response to Senate Bill SB1143 (Liu).

Over the next 12 months, the Task Force will meet to examine best practices and develop innovative reforms designed to improve certificate and degree completion rates. Community colleges are on the front line of serving all students seeking a degree, however, many of these students must overcome significant life challenges in order to graduate. Ensuring access to higher education is only half the equation, equally important is granting students a legitimate opportunity to succeed once they have enrolled.

The task force includes a broad array of academic, research and business leaders. They will examine strategies for promoting student success, including improving student assessment, delivering remedial instruction, increasing access to financial aid and academic counseling and identifying national funding models to incentivize completion rates.

"This is a critical time for Community Colleges and I believe the team that has been assembled has great potential to effect significant, positive change for the system and our students," said Gervin, who is also the President-elect of the California Community College Chief Instructional Officers.

Studies indicate educational attainment is declining nationally with each younger generation. Considering this, Senate Bill 1143 (Liu) calls upon the California Community Colleges Board of Governors to adopt a plan for improving student success by 2012. It also authorizes the creation of a task force on student success.

"Dr. Gervin is an excellent representative for this task force. He is very knowledgeable as to what elements assist our students in becoming successful," said Yosemite Community College District Interim Chancellor, Dr. Joan Smith. "We are proud to have him represent the Yosemite Community College District."
