Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee's 8th Annual Report

MODESTO, CA – The Yosemite Community College District's (YCCD) Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee's (CBOC) 8th Annual Report was presented to the YCCD Board of Trustees at their October Board meeting by CBOC Vice-Chair, Jeff Phillips.

“The CBOC report is produced annually to inform the community as to the status of bond projects and to offer assurance that Measure E funds are spent in accordance with original bond measure requirements said current CBOC Chair, Matthew Rolicheck.

YCCD's Measure E Bond, which passed in November 2004, was a \$326.1 million bond measure for improvements at Columbia College, Modesto Junior College and the expansion of college education sites. According to YCCD Chancellor Dr. Joan Smith, “As our Measure E projects at Modesto Junior College and Columbia College are progressing, I can proudly state that what we planned to serve our students at both colleges is getting accomplished.”
