2020-2021 GOALS/SPECIAL PRIORITIES

1. Prioritize reserve and maintain stability of district...
General Fund reserve criteria which will provide stability to the District when faced with unforeseen State or Local funding shortfalls ([BP6305 Reserves](#))
 - *Establish priorities on when the Board would dip into general fund reserves, and determine percentage of reserve necessary to maintain fiscal stability of the District.*
2. Support the colleges' implementation of the Guided Pathway's initiative, and construct an integrated approach to student success through collaborative educational experiences that support each student from entry to successful transfer and/or attainment of high-quality postsecondary credentials and careers.
3. Support and encourage existing and future partnerships with our K-12 partners through College and Career Access Pathways (CCAP) Agreements and Dual-Enrollment, higher education institutions, business, civic and non-profit organizations to promote and support community college outreach efforts through our chancellor, presidents and the Board.
4. Continue to make campus safety a priority through support of funding and improving safety conditions on campus.
5. Foster an institutional culture that creates a positive educational environment, including utilizing principles that are guided by due process, open discourse, academic freedom, and viewpoint diversity.
6. Aligning the District's COVID-19 reopening plans to the Governor's Resiliency Roadmap and guidance from County Public Health Officer, with input from the colleges "re-opening" planning committees, to measure YCCD's readiness to re-open the District/Colleges to modified and/or full operation.
