



Policy

2220 Committees of the Board

The Board will act as committee of the whole on all items coming before it.

The Board may by action establish committees that it determines are necessary to assist the Board in its responsibilities. Any committee established by Board action shall comply with the requirements of the Brown Act and with these policies regarding open meetings.

At the request of the District governing Board, the Chair shall appoint temporary committees comprised of less than a quorum of the membership, for special purposes. These committees shall be discharged upon completion of their assignments. Board committees that are composed solely of less than a quorum of members of the Board, and do not have authority that may lawfully be exercised by the Board itself, are not required to comply with the Brown Act, or with these policies regarding open meetings, unless they are standing committees.

Board committees have no authority or power to act on behalf of the Board.

Findings or recommendations shall be reported to the Board for consideration.
