



**Policy**

**2430.1 Delegation of Authority to the Presidents**

The President is the Chief Executive Officer of the college. The President reports to, assists, and supports the Chancellor in the performance of the Chancellor’s duties delegated by the Board of Trustees in Board Policy 2430. The President is responsible for implementing the college’s strategic plan and District policies.

The Chancellor supervises, evaluates and delegates the following authority to the College Presidents:

- The executive responsibility for leading and directing all College operations.
- The establishment of administrative procedures necessary for the operation of the College.
- The establishment of administrative organization at the College.
- The performance of all duties specifically required or assigned to him/her by the statutes of the State of California, by the Chancellor and by the Board of Trustees of the Yosemite Community College District.

A new College President shall receive two evaluations within the first year of employment and an annual evaluation every year thereafter.
