



Policy

2432 District Chief Executive Officer (CEO) Succession

The Board delegates authority to the CEO of the District. The CEO of the District is the Chancellor who appoints an acting Chancellor to serve in his/her absence for short periods of time, not to exceed forty-five (45) calendar days at a time.

In the absence of the Chancellor and when an acting Chancellor has not been named, administrative responsibility shall reside with (in order):

Executive Vice Chancellor

The succession order following the Executive Vice Chancellor is at the discretion of the Chancellor and may be selected from the following positions.

- Vice Chancellor of Human Resources
- Assistant Vice Chancellor of Information Technology
- Associate Vice Chancellor of Institutional Research
- College Presidents

For periods exceeding forty-five (45) days, the Board shall appoint an acting Chancellor.
