Policy

3-8072 Unattended Minors

Minors found on campus without legitimate business or without supervision of a parent or guardian will be regarded as "unattended minors" and are not allowed on campus or on other District facilities. Occasional exceptions to this policy may be made with good cause and with the approval of the college president or designee, or District Chancellor or designee.

Administrative Procedure

3-8072 Unattended Minors

The presence of unattended minors presents significant risks in terms of their safety and welfare and presents an issue of institutional liability. If an unattended minor is found on campus, an attempt will be made to contact the minor and determine the whereabouts of the parent or guardian. Campus Safety/Security will be called for assistance as appropriate.

Any unattended minor who is on campus or other District facilities and whose presence or actions interfere with the peaceful conduct of college activities, disrupt its students or staff, or presents a safety risk, will be reported, at a minimum, to Campus Safety/Security.
