Policy

3500 Campus Safety

7 The Board is committed to a safe and secure District work and learning environment. To that end, the 8 Chancellor shall establish a campus safety plan and ensure that it is posted or otherwise made available 9 to students. The campus safety plan shall include availability and location of security personnel, methods 10 for summoning assistance of security personnel, any special safeguards that have been established, any 11 actions taken in the preceding 18 months to increase safety, and any changes in safety precautions to be 12 made during the next 24 months.

Administrative Procedure

2 **3500** Campus Safety

A campus safety plan shall be developed and provided to students. It is incorporated into the annual 4 security report and can be found on each college's Campus Safety and Security website - Modesto Junior 5 6 College: www.yosemite.edu/safety or Columbia College: www.gocolumbia.edu/safety/default.php. A copy can also be obtained by contacting Campus Safety and Security by phone: Modesto Junior College – 7 (209) 575-6351, Columbia College – (209) 588-5167, or in person at the respective college Campus Safety 8 9 and Security office. Campus Safety and Security prepares and annually updates a report of all occurrences reported to campus security personnel of, and arrests for, crimes that are committed on campus and that 10 involve violence, hate violence, theft or destruction of property, illegal drugs, or alcohol intoxication, and 11 of all occurrences of noncriminal acts of hate violence reported to campus authorities. A written report 12 will be submitted to the Board. 13

15 Written records of noncriminal acts of hate violence shall include at least a description of the act of hate 16 violence, the victim characteristics, and offender characteristics, if known.
