## Administrative Procedure

## 4110 Honorary Degrees

Upon the recommendation to the Board of Trustees by the administration, honorary degrees may be conferred when one of the following conditions has been met:

1. Candidate has demonstrated substantial contributions to community college education.

or

- 2. Candidate is a former student who has distinguished himself/herself in work or community activities.
- 14 Nominations may be submitted to the College President by any college staff member. The President, after 15 collegial consultation with the Academic Senate, will submit recommendations to the Chancellor.
