### **Policy**

## 4229 Variable Units Open Entry/Open Exit Course Repetition

The Board directs the Chancellor to establish procedures that ensure the District complies with the appropriate laws, mandates, and statutes regarding course repetition specifically as it relates to variable units open entry/open exit course repetition.

#### **Administrative Procedure**

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The course is required for legally mandated training; or

The course is a special class for students with disabilities which needs to be repeated; or

Variable Units Open Entry/Open Exit Course Repetition

Students may be permitted to enroll in variable unit open-entry/open-exit courses as many times as

Repetition of the course is justified by extenuating circumstances; or

necessary to enable them to complete the entire curriculum of the course once.

Students may not repeat variable unit open-entry/open-exit courses unless:

The student wishes to repeat the course to alleviate substandard work.

A student may not enroll in a variable unit open-entry/open exit active participatory course in physical education, visual arts, or performing arts more than one time.
