4236 Advanced Placement Credit

Any student who passes a College Board Advanced Placement (AP) examination with a minimum score of three in a subject matter will be awarded credit in a general education area with a subject matter similar to that of the AP examination.

If there is no General Education area that fits the AP Examination, the District may award elective credit.

In addition, certain Advanced Placement examination scores may be used to satisfy graduation competency or prerequisite requirements.

Each college shall post its Advanced Placement credit procedures in its college catalog which is posted on its website.
