Policy

Associated Students Elections

The Associated Students shall conduct annual elections to elect officers. The elections shall be conducted in accordance with procedures established by the Chancellor.

Any student elected as an officer in the Associated Students shall meet any of the following requirements:

The student shall be enrolled in the District at the time of election and throughout the student's term of office, with a minimum of five semester units or the equivalent quarter units.

The student shall meet and maintain the minimum standards of scholarship (see BP 4220 titled Standards of Scholarship and related administrative procedures).

The student shall be enrolled in an adult education program offered by the District at the time of the election and throughout the student's term.

The student is enrolled in the District at the time of election, and throughout the student's term, and is a disabled student.
