



Policy

5510 Off-Campus Student Organizations

The District shall work with local law enforcement agencies to monitor and assess criminal activity in which students engage at off-campus locations of student organizations officially recognized by the District.

Per [34 Code of Federal Regulations Section 668.46\(b\)\(7\)](#), the District is required to have this policy, even though currently the District has no officially recognized student organizations with off-campus locations to which it applies, i.e. fraternities or sororities.
