Policy

7600 Campus Safety Officers

 The District shall employ campus safety officers, who shall support student learning by providing services as security guards, or patrol persons on or about the campus(es) owned or operated by the District. Their duties, conducted with the values of YCCD in mind, include, but are not limited to protecting persons or property, preventing the theft of District property, and reporting any unlawful activity to the District and local law enforcement.

The Chancellor shall establish procedures necessary for administration of campus safety. In addition, the Chancellor shall enter into an agreement with local law enforcement, which includes that campus safety officers shall cooperate with local law enforcement in performing their duties.

Every campus safety officer shall complete a course of training developed by the Bureau of Security and Investigative Services of the Department of Consumer Affairs as required by Education Code Section 72330.5(b).

Every campus safety officer shall meet other requirements set out in Education Code Section 72330.5.

shall address, but not be limited to, the following:

Every campus safety officer employed or continuing in employment shall meet the requirements set out in Education Code Section <u>72330.5</u>, including but not limited to:

- Completion of the latest course of training developed by the Bureau of Security and Investigative Services of the Department of Consumer Affairs,
- Submission of two copies of his or her fingerprints which shall be forwarded to the Department of Justice and Federal Bureau of Investigation,
- A determination that the employee is not a person prohibited from employment by a California community college district.

Members of campus safety shall be employed as members of the classified service of the District.
